

## Final information for all registered before arriving to Sweden

### Transfer from Airports

All registered participants for FINA World Masters Championships have free airport transfer to Göteborg and Borås with the Organisers Official Shuttle buses during the Championships from July 24 to August 8.

Bus stop in Göteborg and Borås will be the Official Accreditation Centre at Valhalla Swimming Arena and Borås Swimming Arena.

Our official busses are marked with our official Logo and located outside the airport entrance, where signs direct you to the buses.  
During busy hours extra buses will depart.

Information on departure schedules will be at our Information Centres.

### Alternative transports from the airport to the cities

If you are in a hurry, and do not want to wait for the official transportation, you can take the airport buses to Göteborg city and Borås city.

All accreditations take place in Valhalla Swimming Arena and in Borås Swimming Arena. You can get your accreditation at any of the two venues at your convenience.

Our Organisers Official Shuttle buses will stop outside the accreditation area. On arrival when the accreditation is not open you will be informed of the procedures on the buses.
